TRUST IN JESUS**

Today's feast celebrates another central mystery of our faith—the mystery of the Eucharist. Like the mystery of the Trinity, the real presence of the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist can never be fully understood, but can only be believed. Just as the Israelites in the desert were invited to put their trust in God's word to them, we are invited to trust wholly in the word of Jesus. In today's Gospel Jesus promises to give us a share in his very own flesh and blood, and a share in eternal life besides. We are called to take him at his word and open our hearts to receive true nourishment and life from our participation in the Eucharist.

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

This Sunday, June 18, there will be a Eucharistic procession going from St. Jerome church at 10:30 a.m. (right after 9:30 a.m. Mass) through the streets of our neighborhood.

According to Canon Law "Wherever in the judgment of the diocesan Bishop it can be done, a procession through the streets is to be held, especially on the solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, as a public witness of veneration of the Blessed Eucharist."

SANTA LUCIA PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

Parish Council meeting was held on Wednesday, April 26, 2017 at 7 p.m. in the Parish Hall.

- Meeting started at 7:05 p.m. with a prayer.
- Minutes from April 26, 2017 meeting were read and approved.
- St. Joseph Table Committee meeting held on April 5, 2017. Discussions included: How to use the St. Joseph Table funds? What guideline/criteria to be set up on who will be helped? We will help families in Parish and School in real need of assistance. Gift cards from Jewel will be given. We will help the St. James Food Pantry. Kathy Moore (Director of St. James Food Pantry) will be our guest on May 1. She will talk about the ministry of the St. James Pantry. If we know of someone in need, let Fr. Stipe know.
- Easter: On Easter Vigil we used candles with paper protection. We will go back to using the plastic cups instead of the paper for the candles.
- Fr. Stipe's meeting with Bishop Rojas: Talked about situation at Santa Lucia, challenges, how we are doing. Talked about future growth in Parish; about need of building bridges with other parishes, grow outside our boundaries; be aware of what other Catholic activities are around us.
- Religious education: Elisa Lynn (coordinator of religious education) is retiring. She will help find new coordinator. We need to find a good fit. Teachers need to be certified.
- Upcoming events: Rosary before Masses on Saturday/Sunday in May for us to grow in a prayerful culture. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on 2nd Tuesday of the Month. May Crowning on Wednesday, May 3, at 7 p.m. First Holy Communion on Saturday, May 13. Confirmation on Wednesday, May 24, at St. Jerome.
- Church/Rectory Maintenance:
 - Fr. Stipe proposed that we order a sign that will be in front of church. Recommendation given to include picture of Santa Lucia, Mass schedule etc.
 - Michael Mancine has gotten several estimates regarding the roof/tuck pointing.
- Rogers Auto group would like to advertise in our bulletin. They will give a percentage back to Parish/School for car bought by a parishioner.
- Discussion of adding 3 more members to the Parish Council and with the election to be in October.
- Meeting ended at 8:32 p.m. with a prayer.
